Official Opening of the Morocco Care Centre

Please allow me to introduce myself. Your previous correspondent, Paul Tribble, has gone back to university to undertake further postgraduate study, and I now have the pleasure of fostering our relationship with **The Angus Lawson Memorial Trust**. I understand that The Angus Lawson Memorial Trust has been integral to the establishment of our Care Centre in Morocco, and that the Dental and Consultation Wing is to be named in honour of your son.

We are pleased to announce that the first Comprehensive Care Centre in Morocco will be opening in May, and when we have a fixed date we would be proud to invite you to the event. This Centre is a great achievement, which would not have been possible without your support.

With approximately 1,300 babies born with clefts every year in Morocco, and thousands more people currently living with this deformity, this Centre is desperately needed. Cleft lip and palates affect the breathing, feeding and speech of a baby, as well as bringing significant social isolation. Alongside the initial surgery, the presence of Comprehensive Care Centre allows for ongoing dentistry, speech and orthodontic work for every child who needs it.

As well as providing free surgery, post-operative and follow-up care work, the Comprehensive Care Centre will be the ideal facility to train and educate healthcare professionals. Best practice will be followed as local medical professionals receive training in areas such as basic life support approaches and advanced surgical techniques.

The establishment of this vital facility would not have been possible without your support. The Angus Lawson Dental Care Department will provide much-needed dental care to around 3,000 children in the area, who otherwise would not have been received treatment. Your gift will allow full holistic care for the children of Casablanca, and we would be honoured if you would be able to unveil this dedicated wing.

This vital new project is a great landmark on the Moroccan healthcare landscape. The occasion marks a significant step in the medical care of children and young people in Casablanca, and once we have a set date we will let you know immediately.

As The Angus Lawson Memorial Trust has been so instrumental to the establishment of this vital facility, we feel that it is extremely important that you see first-hand the work that your support has helped to facilitate.
