## 45,000 BREAKFASTS FOR HUNGRY CHILDREN

### MAGIC BREAKFAST - UK

The demand on Magic Breakfast to provide children during lockdown with a nutritious breakfast has increased significantly during this crisis.

## 6 WEEKS OF EMERGENCY FOOD FOR FAMILIES

#### EYLA - UK

Eastside Young Leaders Academy (EYLA) is providing emergency food for six weeks to families in crisis in East London.

# 100 CARE PACKAGES FOR ISOLATED CARE LEAVERS

### SIBLINGS TOGETHER - UK

Siblings Together is providing care packages, daily contact, and support over the phone to 100 young care leavers experiencing severe isolation.

# 250 LAPTOPS FOR HARD TO REACH YOUNG PEOPLE

### BECKMEAD TRUST - UK

The Beckmead Trust is providing 250 laptops for hard-to-reach young people in 'Pupil Referral Units' across England enabling continuity in their education.

## 120 VENTILATOR DAYS FOR PATIENTS

#### MIDLAND DOCTORS - AJK

The provision of 120 Ventilator Days for patients and 180 Continuous Positive Air Pressure Days for virus patients and better health care for the region.

Released funding early where possible for ongoing partner projects.

Approved unrestricted grants for core costs to partner organisations in crisis as a result of the lockdown.

Remained flexible and approachable about existing project outputs.

Provided information on other funding sources and shared good practice.

Identified an accountant to offer free advice to smaller charities on the government support available.


> Funds distributed to date have been approximately 33% International and 67% UK.
